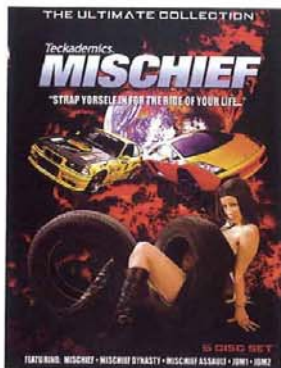
Microfibre technology has changed the car cleaning industry with super soft cloths, towels and wash mitts with better results than any other cloth or chamois before.
