Button Replacement Procedure



1. Open remote with stanly knife on the split line.



2. You will end up with 2 parts. One consisting of electronic component and second with rubber insert.



3. Remove rubber insert from the shell.



4. With small scissors cut out worn button. Discard cut out button as it is not going to be re-used.



5. Press fit Silicone replacement button from outside the shell till it engages with the shell and place remaining rubber gasket back in the shell (the same way it was positioned before)



6. Close both parts of shell.

Once button replacement is finished, remote will work straight away with **no need for re-programming.**
